Dig

1. In verses 27, what is significant about the way the Son of Man will come?

2. What should be the attitude of the believers when they see the Son of Man coming?

3. In verses 29-31, What is the lesson of the fig tree?

4. In verses 32-33, how would the promises have been a comfort to the disciples? A discomfort? What impact do they have on you, 20 centuries later?

5. In the midst of this heavy news and heavy times, how does Jesus caution his followers (verses 34-35)? Why?

6. During this time, what is Jesus' schedule? The schedule of the people? What is significant about these schedules to you?

7. When reading about the parable of the fig tree today, how near is the fig tree to sprouting? What makes you think this? How (if at all) does this affect the way you live your life?

Apply

1. How well does your life reflect verse 36? What will you do this week to become better at watching and praying?
